



## Recycling & Collection of Waste Batteries - Ireland

### Expression of Interest

WEEE Ireland, a producer compliance scheme, hereby invite transportation and recycling companies to submit expressions of interest for any one or all of the following services / operations in regards to the forthcoming Waste Battery Legislation:

#### **Nationwide Collection & Transport system Bulking/Consolidation & Treatment**

Expression of interest should indicate your ability for collection & treatment of **(A)** Portable **(B)** Industrial **(C)** Automotive Batteries. Expressions of interest must specify which categories, services & counties you will quote for.

The Contracts covering all 26 counties in the Republic of Ireland may be split into regions. Bidders can bid for all selected groupings of batteries or for individual regions. WEEE Ireland reserve the right to award the contracts as a package comprising of all components for one or several regions, or award services / operations for any one region to two or more contractors.

The contract period will be for one year with the option of a one year extension. It is planned that the contracts will commence on the 26<sup>th</sup> September 2008.

All expressions of interest must include the following;

- **Company profile;** Description of the company, ownership & organizational structure.
- **Professional capability & experience;** Specific description of core business, competence, experiences & similar assignments.
- **Resources & capacity;** Available resources, operational staff, equipment & technology suitable for fulfilling the requirements above. This should include National or International partners
- **Project strategy & quality insurance;** Overall plan for the project management and implementation. Description of controlling, operation & reporting routines & procedures. Copies of Permits, Licences, ISO, EMAS etc
- **Financial statements;** Annual reports for the last 3 years.

**The expression of Interest for this assignment must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked Expression of Interest WEEE Ireland Batteries and must be returned no later than April 30<sup>th</sup> 2008**
