

WEEE Ireland Schools Battery Recycling Competition 2025-2026 Terms & Conditions

- WEEE Ireland Schools Battery Recycling Competition is open to all Primary and Secondary schools that collect a minimum of 10 full 5kg Battery Boxes in <u>WEEE Ireland Battery</u> Recycling counties.
- 2. Only collections of used batteries, booked with, made by and logged with WEEE Ireland's merchandisers by the competition closing date 30th April 2026 can be counted as entries.
- 3. Entries are automatically logged when collected when collection by WEEE Irelands merchandisers. A minimum of 10 full 5kg boxes is required to book a collection.
- 4. Entry is open from September 2025 to April 2026.
- 5. Prize winners will be notified when all collections are completed.
- 6. There are three entry categories of schools in Primary and three entry categories in Secondary, based on school size/number of students in the school:

Primary schools' categories are:	
SMALL	Less Than 100 Students
MEDIUM	Between 101-299 Students
LARGE	More Than 300 Students
Secondary Schools' categories are:	
SMALL	Less Than 300 Students
MEDIUM	Between 301-599 Students
LARGE	More Than 600 Students

- 7. A prize will be awarded to the school with the highest weight of batteries collected in each of the categories above (3 Primary and 3 Secondary), once all collections are completed.
- 8. Prizes are €2,000 sports vouchers, 1 each per winning school (6 overall winners; 3 Primary and 3 Secondary).
- 9. Prizes are non-transferable and no cash alternative is available.
- 10. Unauthorised removal of waste batteries of any type from registered WEEE Ireland Battery Collection Points (retailer, recycling centre, business or other) is not permitted.
